- ~33% of total Revenue


### Committed to Service Capital Budget Breakout



- Capital Budget Project categories:
  - ➤ Roadways & Intersections \$33.0M
  - ➤ Capital Maintenance \$12.6M
  - ➤ Community Programs \$8.0M
  - ➤ Co-operative/Development \$4.2M
  - ➤Bridges \$4.4M
  - ➤Traffic \$1.2M
  - >Stormwater \$500k







### Submit a Community Programs Application


- Provides citizens & neighborhood groups with a clear and direct way to request enhancement projects in the public right-of-way.


