A street that balances all users' needs - motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, transit, people with disabilities - with adjacent land uses.

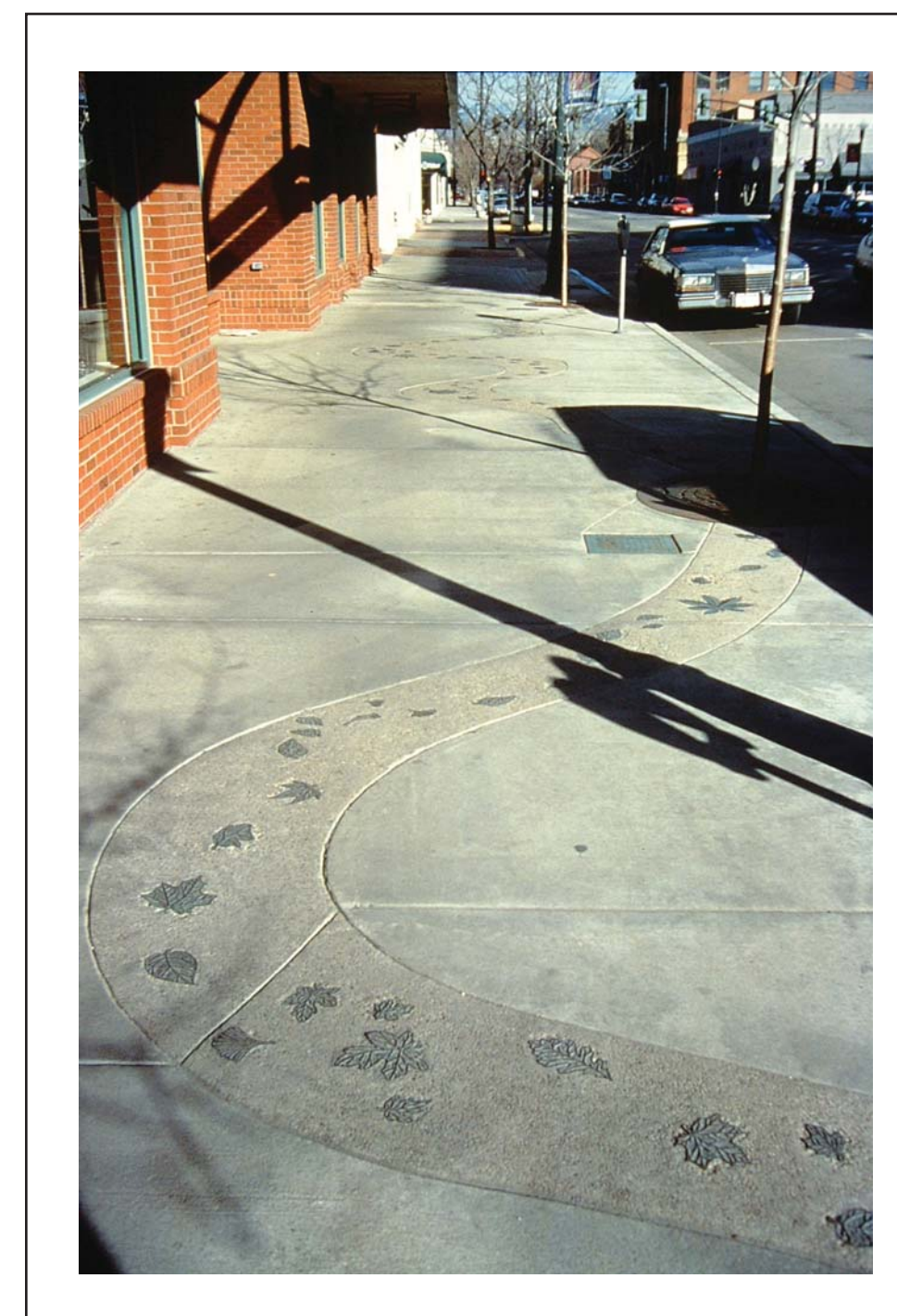
Livable Streets can include:



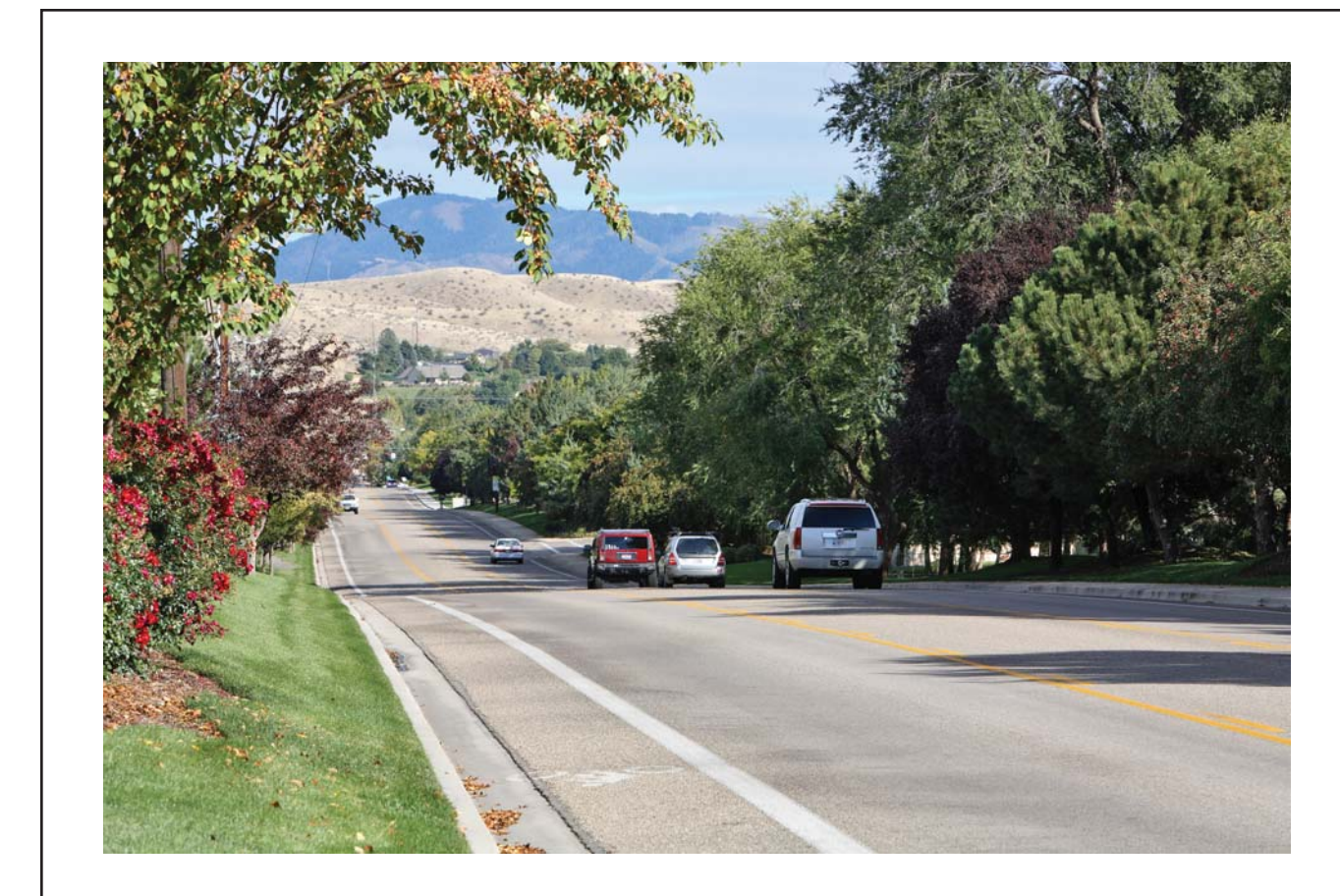
Bike lanes

Decorative concrete



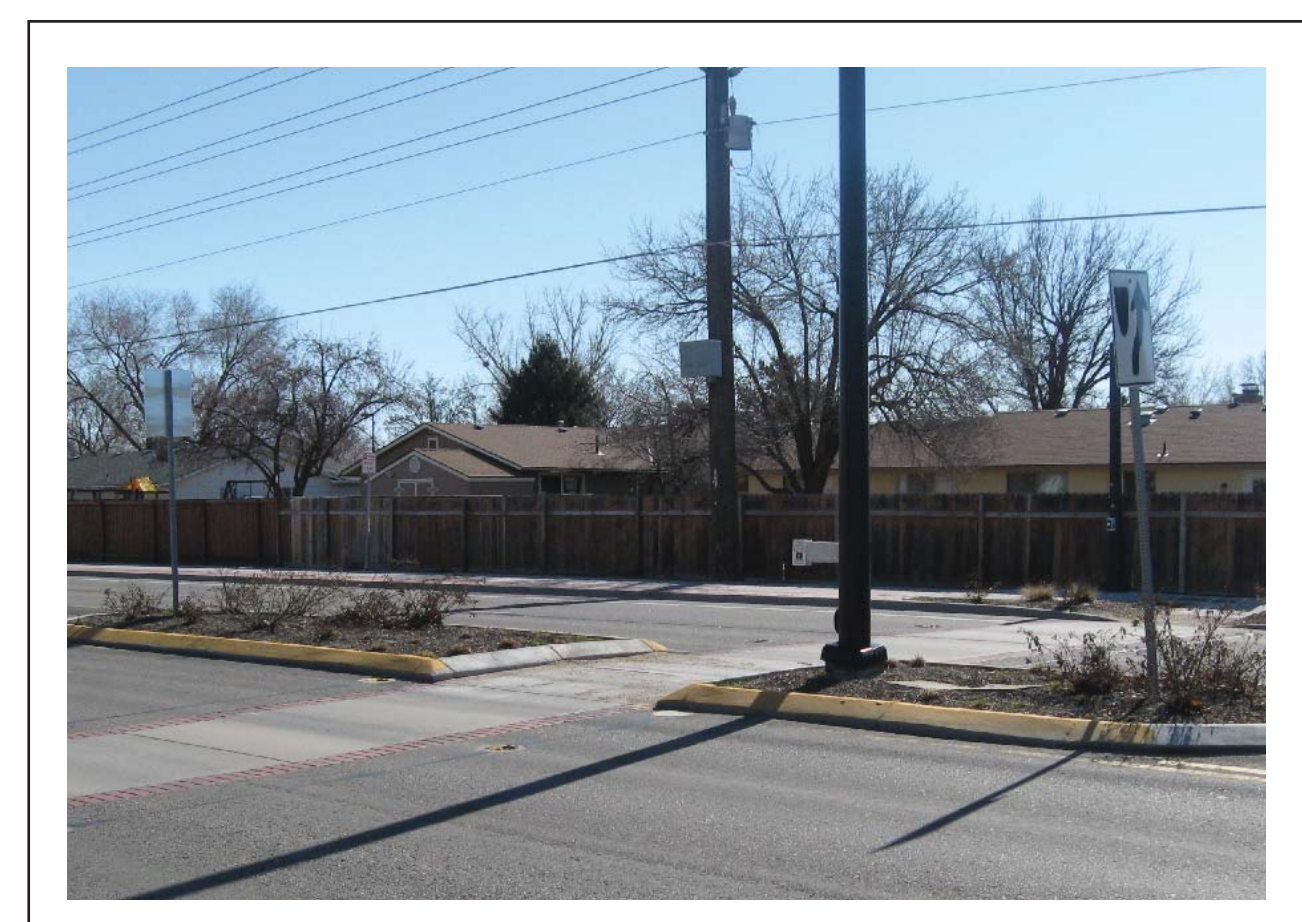
Parking options



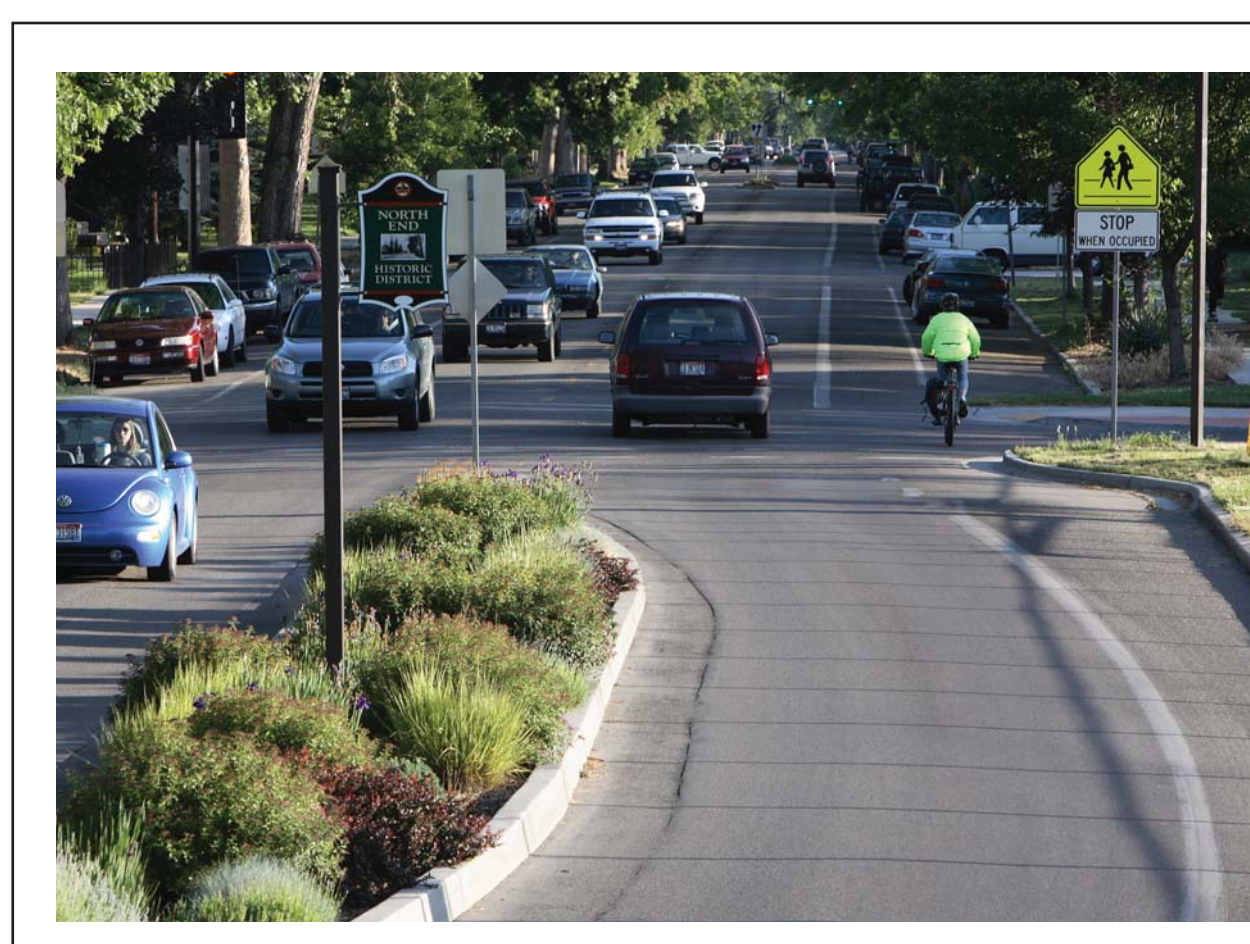
Traffic calming
